

was advised of his right to report any of these individuals to the Department if he feels they are fraudulently or mistakenly receiving more Food Stamps than they are entitled to.

ORDER

The Department's decision is affirmed.

REASONS

Inasmuch as the petitioner does not dispute that Department's decision in this matter accurately reflects his income and expenses and is in accord with the applicable regulations, the Board is bound by law to affirm.¹ 3 V.S.A. § 3091(d), Fair Hearing Rule No. 17.
