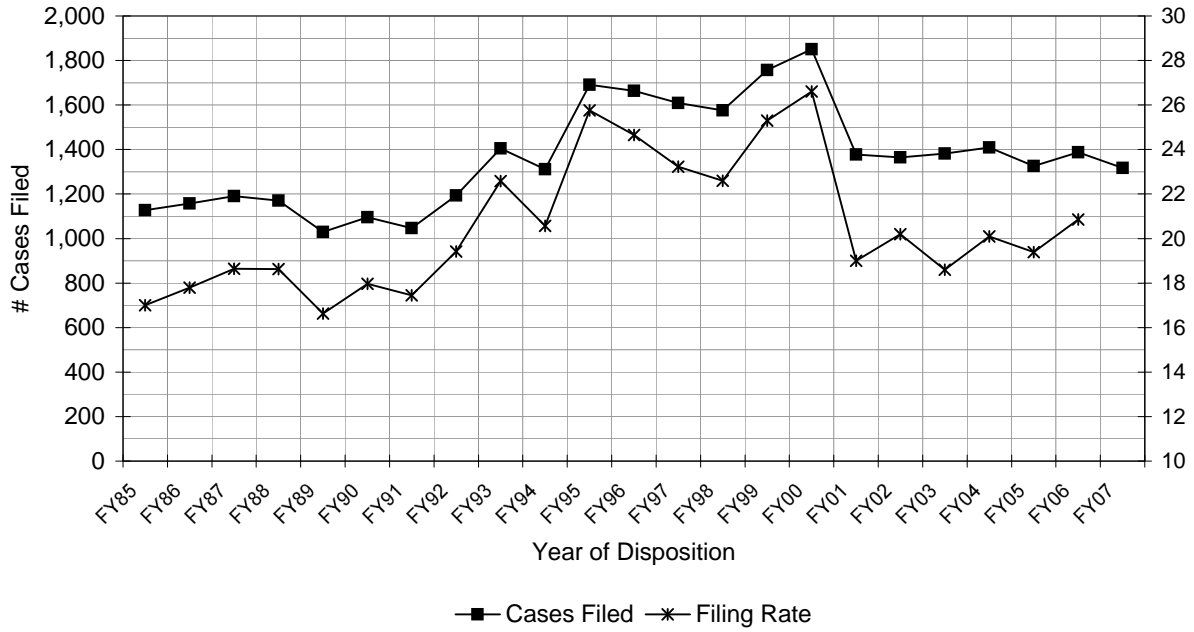

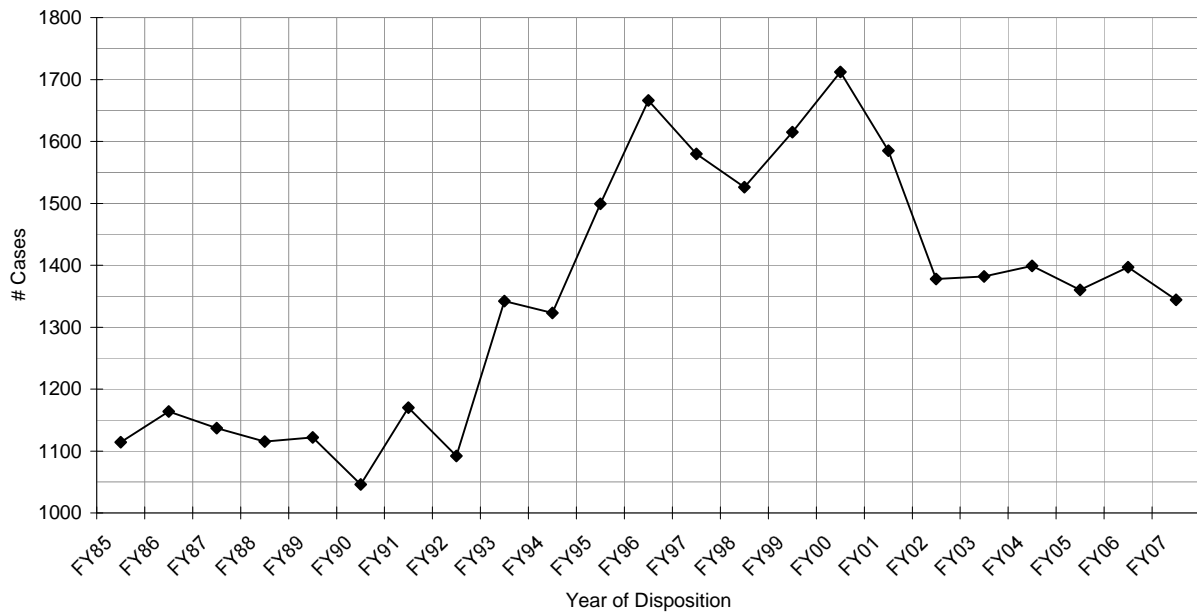

### Juvenile Delinquency Cases Disposed FY85 - FY07



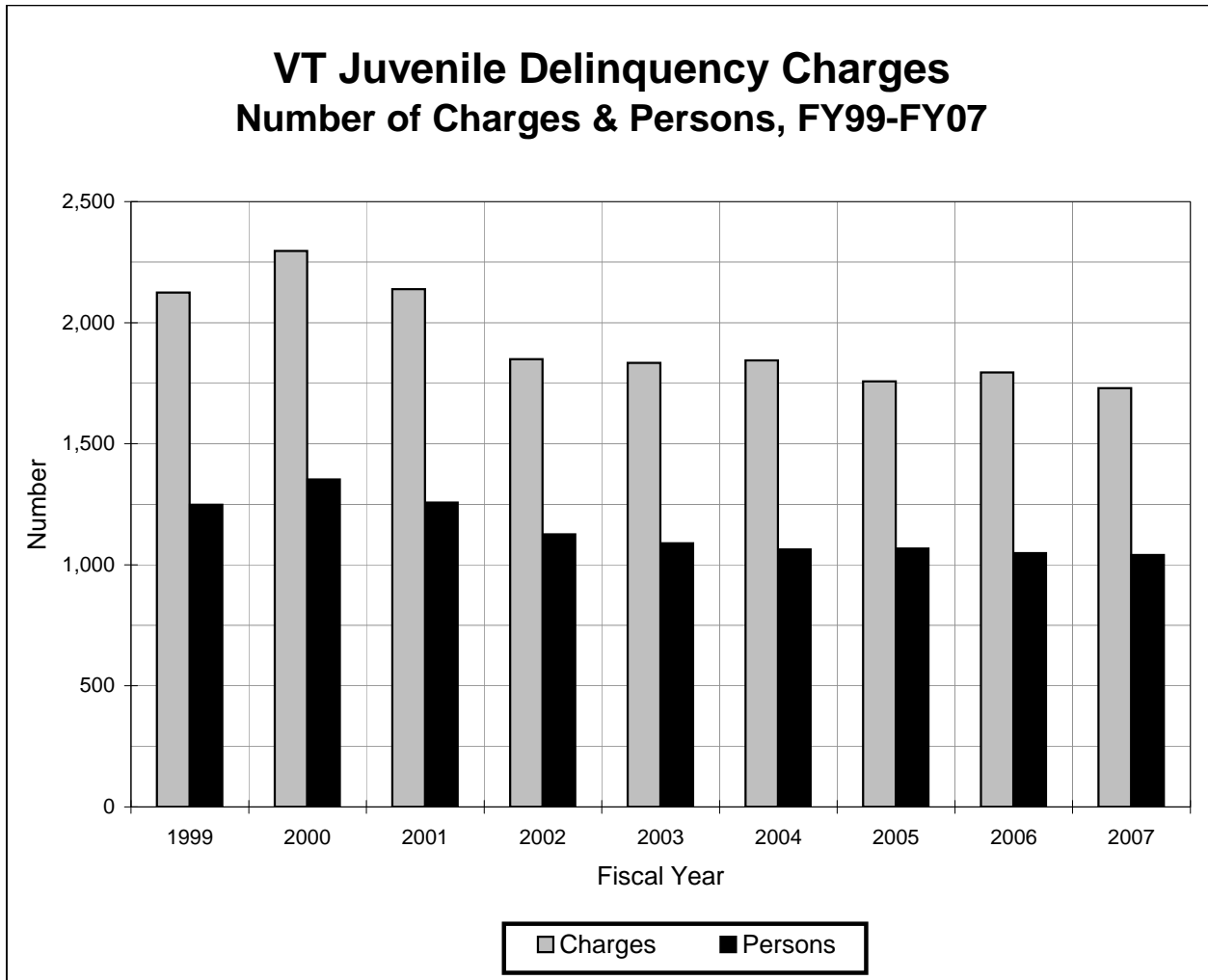

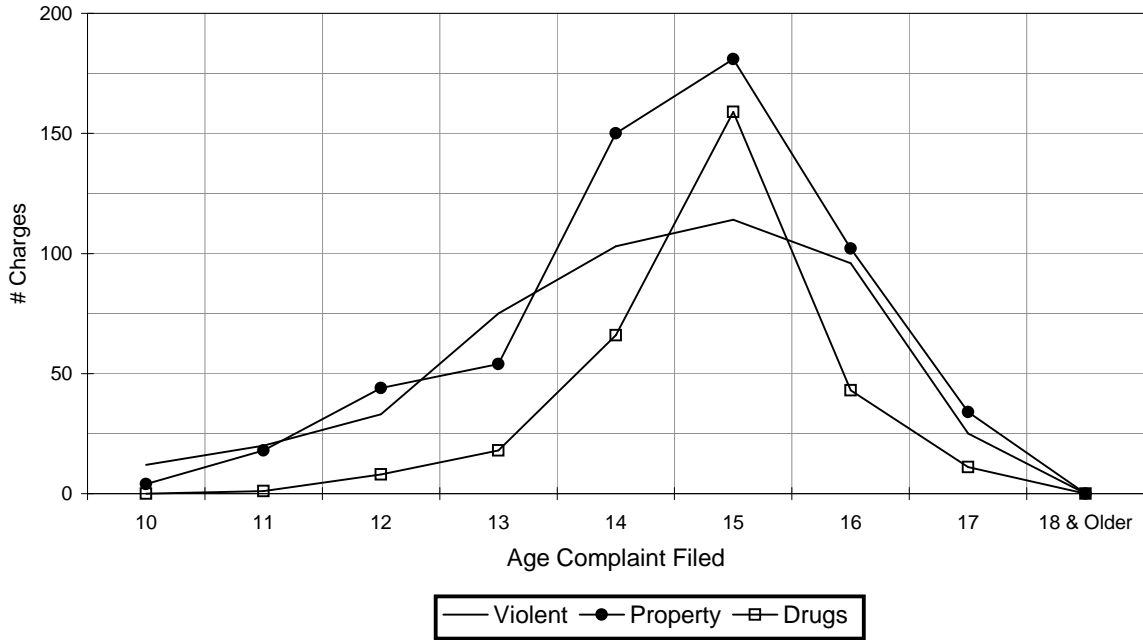

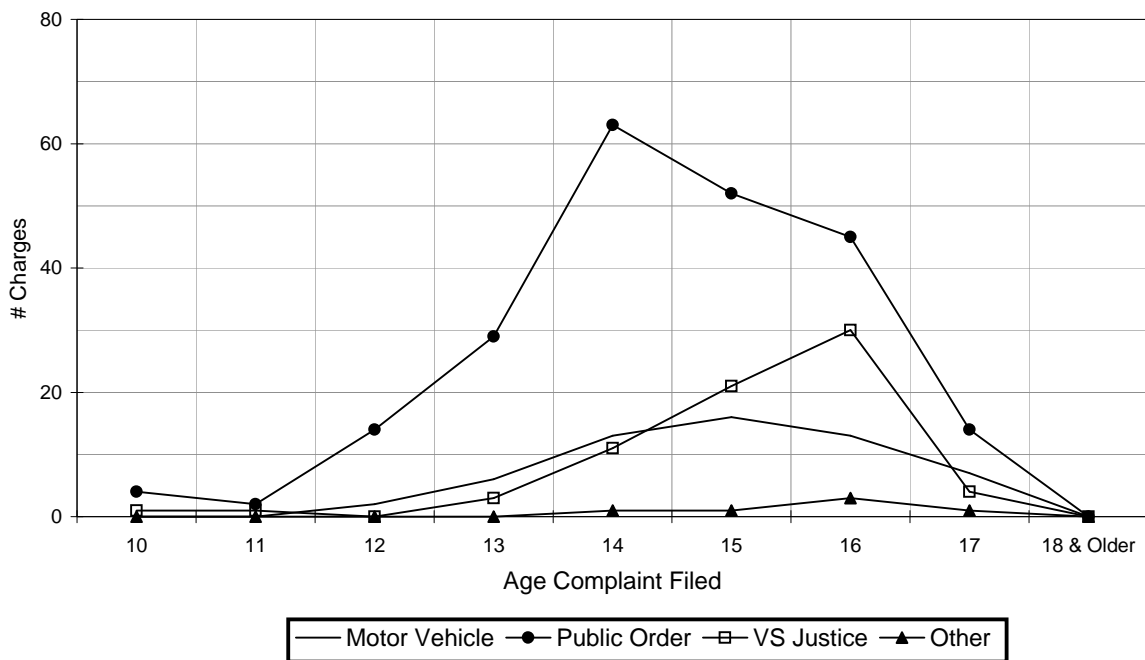

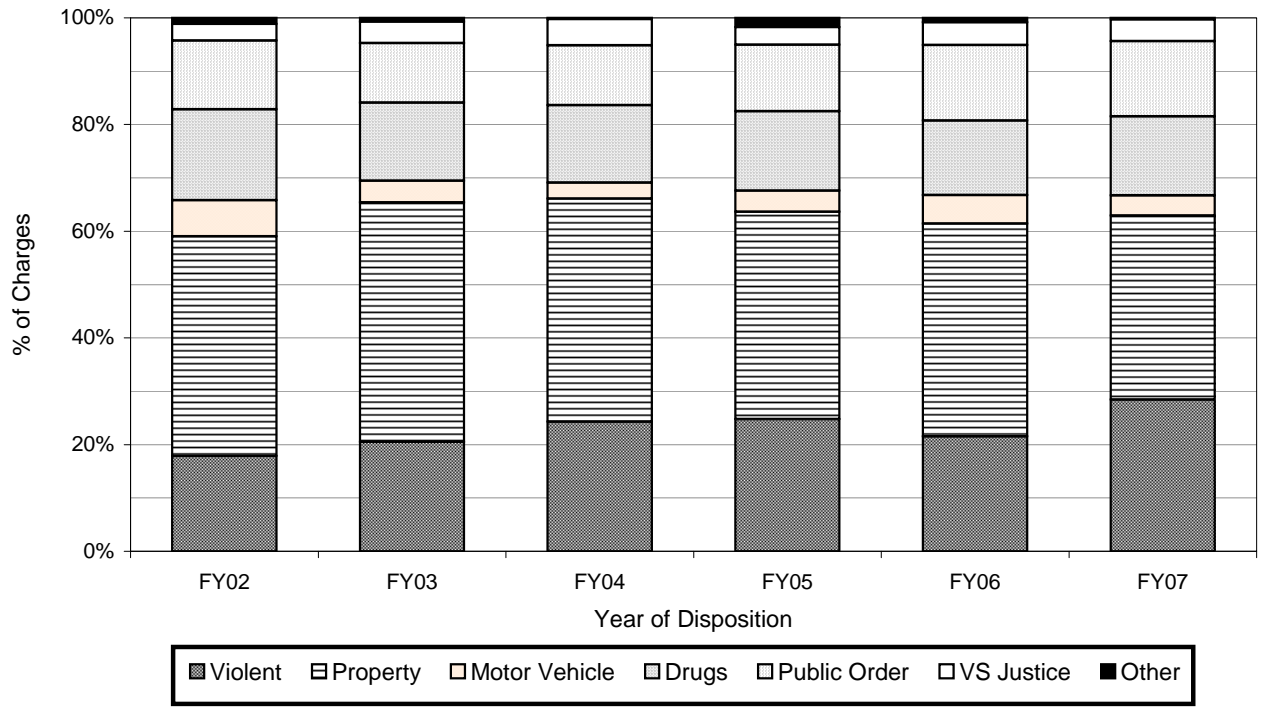

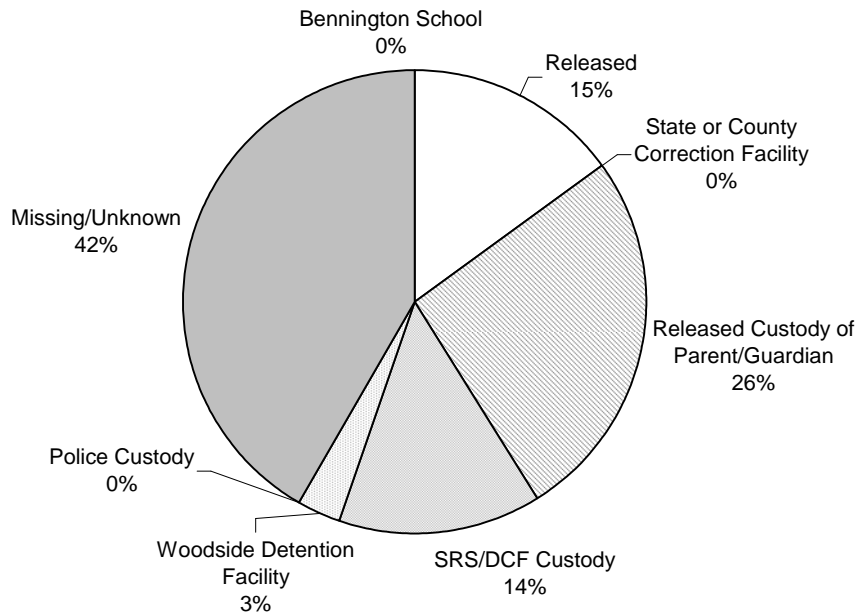

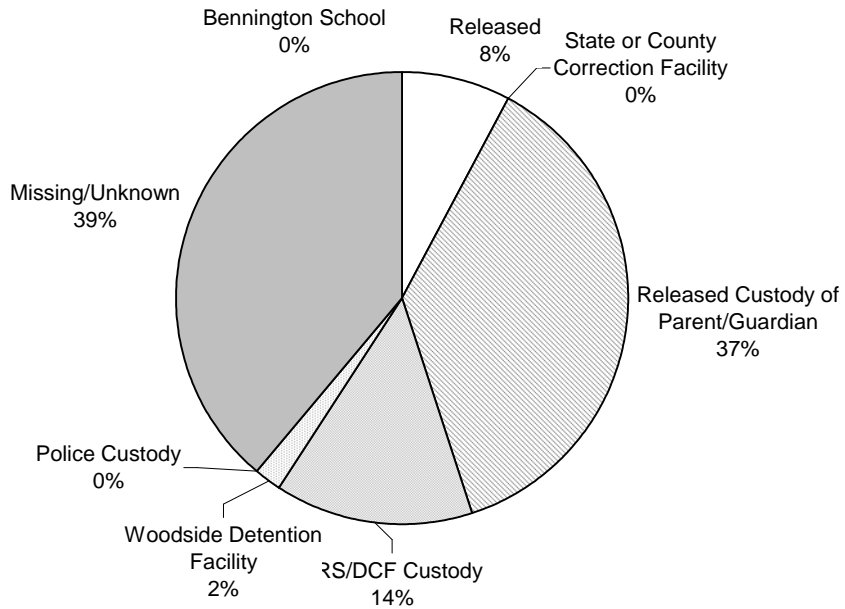

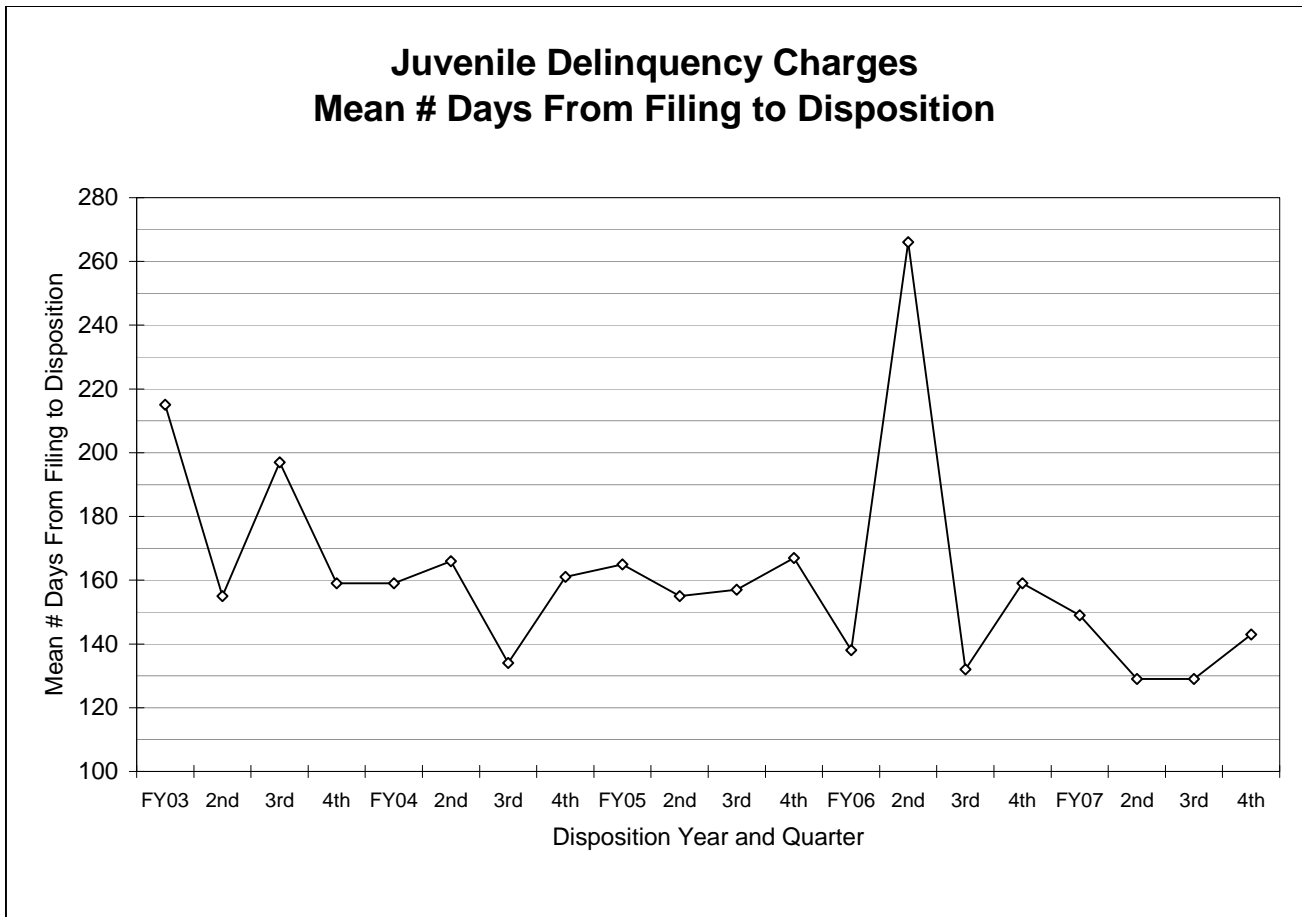
