Bridge Care Coordination Reimbursement

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to increase the maximum and minimum case rate for Bridge Care Coordination. Bridge Care Coordination is a targeted case management service for children with developmental disabilities and is billed at a per member per month (PMPM) rate. The minimum billed case rate is being increased from \$173 to \$196 PMPM. The maximum billed case rate is being increased from \$224 to \$244 PMPM. This rate increase is part of the State Fiscal Year 2023 budget appropriation from the Vermont State Legislature.
