Integrating Family Services Rate Increase

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to increase the rate paid to the Addison County Parent Child Center (ACPCC), one of the Integrating Family Services (IFS) providers. The ACPCC bundled payment will increase from \$843.42 to \$910.89 per member per month. This change is part of the 8% rate increase mandated by the Vermont Legislature under Act 185 of the 2022 session.

The IFS bundled payment model supports Medicaid services for pregnant individuals and children birth through age 21 across service domains, including: mental and behavioral health, developmental disabilities, and substance use. Services reach across the continuum of prevention, diagnosis, and treatment.
