Residential Substance Use Disorder Treatment Value-Based Payment Model

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to continue the value-based component of the payment model for the Substance Use Residential Treatment payment model. The payment model remains unchanged for calendar year 2025. Beginning with calendar year 2023, the Vermont Department of Health's residential substance use treatment facility episodic rate model incorporated provider results on three performance measures into payment through a reconciliation process.

Residential substance use treatment providers will earn points based on performance across three different measures and can earn up to \$75,000 across all providers, representing roughly 1% of estimated expenditures in the program. This value-based component is designed to incentivize timely treatment and aftercare plans, as well as engagement in clinically optimal lengths of stay.
