# **Mental Health Case Rate Update**

## **Policy Summary:**

The Vermont Medicaid program is updating the Mental Health Case Rate payment model for calendar year 2023. Updates include:

- 1. Creation of an emergency services global payment (ESGP) using Vermont's most recent statewide Medicaid penetration rate and the census of each provider's catchment area to arrive at a single, fixed monthly payment for all low-threshold emergency services to Medicaid beneficiaries of all age groups. Low-threshold services meet the billing requirements for code H2011. Providers are expected to ensure that the total cost for all low-threshold services does not exceed the total capitation amount.
- 2. Addition of a payment tied to reducing the percentage of services/assessments that occur in emergency departments. This value-based payment totals \$971,000 and will be distributed to providers based on performance, with no provider earning more than 1% of their annual allocation. This payment is in addition to the existing 2% value-based payment for established measures. Providers can achieve the value-based payment for decreasing the percentage of crisis services/assessments that occur in emergency departments in one of two ways:
  - a. Achieving a 5% bi-annual (6-month) decrease in percentage of crisis services/assessments that occurred in emergency departments from baseline period (based on previous 3 years of Monthly Service Report [MSR] submissions by respective designated agency), or
  - b. Achievement of 90th Percentile (highest achievable benchmark) of crisis services/assessments not delivered in emergency departments from baseline period (based on previous 3 years of MSR submissions by all designated agencies).
- 3. Alignment of Adult and Children's case rate value-based payment measures with the Integrating Family Services program measures.
