<u>Inpatient and Residential Eating Disorder Treatment – Change to</u> <u>Utilization Management</u>

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to change how it conducts utilization management for inpatient and residential levels of care for eating disorder treatment. Currently, eating disorder treatment providers are required to submit prior authorization for admission to inpatient and residential levels of care for Medicaid members. Effective January 1, 2023, the Vermont Medicaid program will conduct concurrent review of clinical documentation for these admissions. This means providers will not need to submit documentation <u>prior</u> to admission for these two levels of care for eating disorder treatment. Providers are responsible for determining if treatment is medically necessary and meets clinical criteria for admission.
