GCR 23-021 PROPOSED

Children's Personal Care Services Rate Update

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to update the Medicaid rate on file for Children's Personal Care Services (CPCS). The Medicaid rate on file is used to calculate individual, self-directed budgets for CPCS. Under self-directed budgets for CPCS, it is consumers and family members who set provider wages. Effective July 1, 2023, the Medicaid rate on file for CPCS will increase from \$13.74 per hour to \$15.00 per hour (plus payroll tax).

The Medicaid rate on file for CPCS that is used to calculate individual budgets is different than the minimum rate for provider services established as a result of a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) for direct support workers between the State of Vermont and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSME). The minimum rate for CPCS under the CBA effective July 1, 2023, will increase to \$14.05 per hour (plus payroll tax). Employers of record for a child's CPCS budget will retain the ability to pay a flexible wage, but not below the minimum rate under the CBA.
