Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Spending Plan Narrative Update

Policy Summary:

Section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan Act provides states with additional federal funding for Medicaid HCBS. States received a time-limited 10 percentage point increase to the federal medical assistance percentage (FMAP) for certain Medicaid expenditures from April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022. These funds present an unprecedented opportunity to enhance, expand and strengthen HCBS under the Medicaid program. The Agency of Human Services (AHS) submitted an Initial Spending Plan Narrative in June 2021 outlining Vermont's plan to utilize the HCBS FMAP funding (see [GCR 21-039](#)) and an updated Spending Plan Narrative in July 2022 (see [GCR 22-075](#)). In accordance with guidance from CMS, AHS submitted an updated HCBS Spending Plan Narrative on January 17, 2023. The updated Narrative includes revised spending projections and reports on the state's progress towards implementing approved activities. Effective Date:

The enhanced FMAP was available from April 1, 2021 – March 2022. States are permitted to use the state funds equivalent to the amount of federal funds attributable to the increased FMAP through March 31, 2025.
