GCR 23-025 PROPOSED

RBRVS Fee Schedule Update

Policy Summary:

The Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) is updating its Medicaid State Plan reimbursement methodology for Resource-Based Relative Value Scale (RBRVS) payments, including changes to the primary care conversion factor, the standard conversion factor, and the Geographic Practice Cost Index (GPCI).

In keeping with the process of using the best available data and alignment with Medicare, DVHA will adopt the calendar year 2023 Medicare relative value units (RVUs), which are the basis of RBRVS payments and reflect the most recent data published by the Centers for Medicare and Medicare Services (CMS). The primary care conversion factor will decrease from \$34.60 to \$33.89. The standard conversion factor will decrease from \$28.54 to \$28.30. This is consistent with Medicare's decrease.

In addition to the changes above, the 2023 GPCI for Vermont has changed as follows:

- Practice Expense GPCI decreased from 1.015 to 0.997.
- Malpractice GPCI decreased from 0.595 to 0.543.

Medicaid State Plan

This change is being done through Global Commitment to Health waiver authority, where DVHA may establish rates with providers on an individual or class basis without regard to the rates currently set forth in the approved State Plan.

Global Commitment to Health Waiver: Waiver authority #5 [Section 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30)]; Special Term and Condition #6.8.

The estimated gross annualized budget impact is a savings of \$380,551.
