Emergency Department Reimbursement for Mental Health Extended Stays

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program made permanent reimbursement to hospitals for extended Emergency Department (ED) stays in which a Vermont Medicaid member meets clinical criteria for inpatient psychiatric level of care <u>and</u> there are no beds available for placement (see <u>GCR 22-069</u>). Effective May 11, 2023, this per diem rate will be reimbursed at the per diem rate established by the Division of Rate Setting for swing beds. This means the per diem rate will increase from \$200 to \$265.83.

Hospitals may submit an authorization request to the Department of Vermont Health Access when a member meeting criteria exceeds a 24-hour stay in the ED. Reimbursement will not cover the day of admission and the day of discharge from the ED.
