Northeastern Family Institute Case Rate Update

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program has increased reimbursement for the Northeastern Family Institute (NFI) bundled case rate. NFI is the only statewide Specialized Service Agency in Vermont for children and youth with severe emotional disturbance and their families. NFI provides intensive wraparound services in multiple regions of the state in home, therapeutic foster home, staffed transitional living, and community settings with a strong clinical approach to address complex trauma and attachment issues.

NFI will receive \$1,851.35 per member per week, which represents a 5% rate increase from the previous year in alignment with appropriations made by the Vermont Legislature under H.494 of the 2023 session. NFI is also eligible for up to a 5% incentive payment if it meets utilization expectations by serving at least 91 individuals in a year and meets performance measure expectations detailed in the Additional Information section below.
