GCR 23-080 PROPOSED

Compression Garment Providers

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to expand the provider types who may dispense compression garments. This change is intended to increase members' access to compression garments by allowing physical therapists, occupational therapists, and podiatrists to dispense compression garments as medically necessary.

Physical therapists and occupational therapists may dispense upper and lower compression garments according to an ordering provider's prescription. Podiatrists may order and dispense lower compression garments. Coverage and reimbursement for these items of durable medical equipment is according to the Medicaid fee schedule found on the Department of Vermont Health Access website. The clinical coverage criteria and reimbursement are the same for all provider types.
