Payment Update for Second Spring Residential Care

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to update its payment methodology for Second Spring North and South, which are intensive residential care facilities serving the Community Rehabilitation and Treatment (CRT) population. The facilities will receive an estimated daily rate of \$973.27, which represents anticipated costs to meet the target utilization of 90% of the total bed days available. At the end of the fiscal year a reconciliation will be done. New rates will be established to ensure that actual costs are covered plus a gain of 1.5% up to the maximum budget for this service.

Daily rates do not include the cost of room and board.
