**Background:** The new Program is for Medicaid enrollees age 18 and older eligible for full Medicaid State Plan benefits who meet the health and risk criteria defined by the state. The program will provide eligible individuals with access to housing navigation (also called pre-tenancy) supports, housing retention (also called tenancy sustaining) services, and community transition services for enrollees moving to permanent supportive housing.

The VT Agency of Human Services (AHS) has contracted with the Technical Assistance Collaborative (TAC) to conduct a statewide stakeholder engagement process on VT's Medicaid Supportive Housing Assistance Program.
