- <u>The adult vaccine purchasing program is administered by the Vermont Department of Health. The</u> reimbursement methodology for the adult vaccine purchasing program is a per member per month rate. The rate is set annually in April and effective July 1. The rate is calculated using a reconciliation of prior year program revenue and expenses, and estimated vaccine cost and utilization, program operating and administrative costs, and assessable covered lives for the state fiscal year starting July 1.

Payment methodology for vaccine administration is Resource-Based Relative Value (RBRVS). Attachment 4.19-B Item 26
