**15. Residential Eating Disorder Treatment**

Eating disorder treatment services offered in residential settings provide diagnosis, treatment, and care of persons in a sub-acute psychiatric management environment. Individuals receive care in a residential setting based on a developed plan of care. Residential eating disorder treatment is covered only when deemed medically necessary.

Medical necessity is determined by the Medicaid program through a concurrent review process.

Residential eating disorder treatment services can be provided by a variety of health care professionals including physicians, psychologists, social workers, psychiatric nurses, mental health professionals, and other licensed mental health professionals operating in their scope of practice. Participating residential treatment providers must be enrolled in Vermont Medicaid to participate in and receive reimbursement for services they provide.

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
