Pharmacy COVID-19 Test Kit Limits

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to change the number of over the counter (OTC) COVID-19 self-tests obtained per prescription at Medicaid enrolled pharmacies. Effective February 15, 2024, the number of tests allowed per prescription will change from 8 tests to 4 tests per prescription, every 15 days. This change will continue to allow 8 OTC COVID-19 tests every 30 days. Additional tests may be covered when medically necessary with prior authorization.

Vermont Medicaid enrolled pharmacists may prescribe COVID-19 tests within their scope of practice. More information on testing and Medicaid covered tests can be found in the additional information below.
