Hospice Services Rate Changes

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program is conducting its annual update of the rates for hospice services. Vermont Medicaid follows the Medicare rate methodology for hospice services and will set the 2024 rates for hospice services at 100% of the Medicare rates. Further details on the rate changes can be found under "Additional Information" below.

Effective Date:

January 1, 2024

Authority/Legal Basis:

Medicaid State Plan

This change is being done through Global Commitment to Health waiver authority, where DVHA may establish rates with providers on an individual or class basis without regard to the rates currently set forth in the approved State Plan.

<u>Global Commitment to Health Waiver</u>: Waiver authority #5 [Section 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30)]; Special Term and Condition #6.8.

The estimated gross annualized budget impact is \$26,000.
