Mental Health Case Rate Update

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program updated the Mental Health Case Rate payment model. Funding that was previously a part of the Emergency Services Global Payment shifted into the case rates for children with or at risk of Severe Emotional Disturbance and for adults with Serious Mental Illness. Low-threshold emergency services delivered to Medicaid beneficiaries are billed to the children and adult case rates.

Authority/Legal Basis: Medicaid State Plan
