VPharm Child Support Disregard Increased to \$100.00 per month

Policy Summary:

The Agency of Human Services (AHS) has increased the child support disregard for determining VPharm eligibility from \$50.00 per month to \$100.00 per month, effective February 8, 2024. This change will mean that a VPharm applicant or enrollee can receive more child support before it is considered income for VPharm eligibility purposes. This change aligns with a change in the Reach Up program in which the child support disregard was increased from \$50.00 to \$100.00 per month, pursuant to 33 V.S.A. 1105(a).

Population Affected: All VPharm applicants and enrollees who have child support income over \$50.00 per month.
