GCR 24-033 PROPOSED

Wheelchair Component Prior Authorization Change

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to remove the prior authorization requirement for wheelchair components and accessories that are an exact replacement as part of a wheelchair repair. Previously, prior authorization was required for all repairs greater than \$500. Providers are expected to continue to maintain documentation of medical necessity for any repairs.

Any prior authorization requirements for wheelchairs, components, or accessories can be found on the Medicaid Fee Schedule and Imminent Harm Code List.

<u>Health Care Administrative Rule 4.210 Wheelchairs, Mobility Devices and Seating Systems</u> will be amended to remove the prior authorization requirement for wheelchair repairs costing more than \$500.
