Sleep Study Prior Authorization Change

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to remove prior authorization requirements for facility-based sleep studies. Facility-based sleep studies do not require prior authorization for Medicaid members who are attributed to the Accountable Care Organization (ACO). This change aligns sleep study prior authorization requirements for all Vermont Medicaid members regardless of ACO attribution.

A review of utilization data identified high approval rates for facility-based sleep studies and supports that prior authorization is not necessary as a utilization control.
