GCR 24-058 PROPOSED

Non-Emergency Transportation Temporary Rate Increase

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to temporarily increase the per member, per week (PMPW) rate for non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT) services. Beginning on payment date June 14, 2024, through payment date June 28, 2024, the rate paid will be an enhanced rate of \$106.25. Following the temporary rate increase, the prevailing PMPW rate of \$40.00 will be in effect. The contract with Vermont Medicaid's NEMT Broker, Vermont Public Transit Association (VPTA), is being amended to reflect this temporary increase to the PMPW rate. This payment rate update was required under Act No. 113 Sec. C.101 of 2024 and is consistent with the SFY 2024 appropriation provided by the Vermont Legislature to cover provider costs and maintain service provider stability.

May 31, 2024 – June 30, 2024

Authority/Legal Basis:

Medicaid State Plan

This change is being done through Global Commitment to Health waiver authority, where DVHA may establish rates with providers on an individual or class basis without regard to the rates currently set forth in the approved State Plan.

Global Commitment to Health Waiver: Waiver authority #5 [Section 1902(a)(13), 1902(a)(30)]; Special Term and Condition #6.8.

Act 113 of 2024 as enacted by the Vermont Legislature

Population Affected:

All Medicaid.

This change is expected to be budget neutral.
