Rate Increase for Community-Based Mobile Crisis Services

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to increase the Community-Based Mobile Crisis payments by 3%. This increase is a result of funds appropriated by the legislature in Bill H.883. That rate increases are as follows:

- The rate will increase from \$571.39 to \$588.53 per mobile team dispatch into the community where the client is located. The rate will increase from \$683.50 to \$704.00 for overnight/weekend
- The rate will increase from \$350.94 to \$361.47 per mobile team assisting clients at an eligible office location. The rate will increase from \$425.72 to \$438.49 for overnight/weekend.

Community-Based Mobile Crisis provides 24/7/365 community-based mobile crisis services to achieve a statewide mobile crisis response system of care that meets the needs of individuals of all ages experiencing a mental health and/or substance use crisis. The prospective payment methodology outlined in [GCR:23-132](#) remains the same.
