GCR 24-102 PROPOSED

Coverage Change for COVID-19 At-Home Over-the-Counter Tests

Policy Summary:

The Vermont Medicaid program proposes to discontinue coverage of over-the-counter COVID-19 self-diagnostic antigen tests in the pharmacy benefit at the end of the COVID-19 coverage period.

Effective October 1, 2024, the Vermont Medicaid program will no longer provide coverage for at-home COVID-19 antigen tests in the pharmacy benefit program. Coverage will remain in place for COVID-19 tests administered by Medicaid enrolled providers including in a medical provider's office, or clinic, or as inpatient or outpatient hospital services.

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 required a coverage period for all types of COVID-19 tests, including at-home COVID-19 tests, from March 11, 2021, through September 30, 2024. This was submitted to CMS as a time limited State Plan Amendment (SPA# 23-0013) and noticed in GCR 23-027.
