MS. ALLIGOOD: I am Mary Ann Alligood, a financial director with the Vermont Agency of Human Services. Under federal regulation we must, at the beginning of each federal fiscal year, conduct a public hearing and notification of that public hearing for these federal block grants administered by AHS.

Today I have with me members from each department who can address any specific concerns or questions regarding these I believe you all received prior grants. to today's hearing a summary of the block grants. I should also note that these block grants and the respective programs and amounts, for the most part, were approved as part of the last legislative session as part of fiscal year 2013 budget contained in the Appropriations Act, Act 162 of the Acts of 2012. Currently, the federal appropriations bill supporting these block grants are under review. The estimated allocations remain consistent with these

presentations with the exception of the Preventive Health Block Grant, which may be eliminated in the federal appropriation process. Until enacted into law, we will use the known distributions at this time.

At this time if you should have any questions, we would be happy to address those questions and if anyone from the public is here, we would be happy to answer their questions. If for any reason we don't have the information readily available to us, it will be provided to you as soon as possible.
