2	MS. ALLIGOOD: This is the public
3	hearing on AHS block grants and I am Mary
4	Ann Alligood, a financial director with
5	the Vermont Agency of Human Services.
6	Under federal regulation we must at the
7	beginning of each federal fiscal year
8	conduct a public hearing and notification
9	of that public hearing for these federal
10	block grants administered by AHS.
11	Today I have with me members from each
12	department who can address any specific
13	concerns or questions regarding these
14	grants. I believe you all received prior
15	to today's meeting a summary of the block
16	grants. I should also note that these
17	block grants and the respective programs
18	and amounts for the most part were
19	approved as part of last legislative
20	session as part of the federal fiscal
21	year 2015 budget contained in the
22	Appropriations Act, Act 179 of the Acts
23	of 2014. Currently, the federal
24	appropriations bill supporting these
25	block grants are under review. The

estimated allocations remain consistent 1 2 with these presentations with the 3 exception of the Preventive Health Block 4 Grant which may be eliminated in the 5 federal appropriations process. Until 6 enacted into law we will use the known 7 distribution at this time.

8 At this time if you have any questions 9 we would be happy to address those 10 questions and if anyone from the public 11 is here we would be happy to answer their 12 questions. If for any reason we don't 13 have the information readily available to 14 us, it will be provided to you as soon as 15 Does anyone have questions? possible. 16 We did get one e-mail from the public. 17 It is from Mark Redmond of Spectrum VT. 18 He says, Sherie, I cannot make this 19 meeting but my statement at the meeting 20 would have been to advocate that dollars 21 be allocated in the category of special 22 services youth at risk. I'm thinking of 23 our drop-in center which had for many 24 years received federal run-away and 25 homeless youth dollars but does not any

1 longer and at the same time for our 2 transitional living residences which are 3 in the same situation. I know this is 4 the case for other drop-in centers for 5 at-risk youth too and for transitional 6 living. We have all watched federal 7 funds dry up. I would greatly appreciate 8 seeing some SSBG funds allocated for this 9 purpose. Thanks, Mark. Mark Redmond, 10 Executive Director, Spectrum Youth and 11 Family Services. 12 And that was the only comment we had. 13 So if you'd like we can -- we would just 14 pause for ten minutes or so and give 15 people time to come in if they were lost 16 or at the wrong building on Hurricane 17 Lane or something. 18 (Recess) 19 MS. ALLIGOOD: It's 2:15 and no one 20 from the public has arrived and we don't 21 have any additional questions. So we can 22 officially consider the meeting closed. 23 Thank you. 24 (Whereupon, the hearing was adjourned 25 at 2:16 p.m.)
