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PROCEEDINGS
MG. GOULD: Let's go on record. Good morning. My name is Jill Gould. I amthe financial director of Northern Vermont Agency of Human Servi ces. Under feder al regul ation we must at the begi nning of each federal year conduct our public hearing and notification of that publ ic hearing for these federal block grants admi ni st ered by HS.

Today I have with me menbers from departments who can address any specific concerns or questions regarding these grants. I bel i eve you all recei ved prior to today's hearing a summary of the bl ock grants. I should al so note that these bl ock grants and the respective prograns and amounts for the most part were approved as part of our last legi slative session as part of the fiscal year 2006 Budget Cont ai nment Appropriations Act, Act 58 of the Acts of 2015.

Currently the federal appropriations bill supporting these block grants are under revi ew. The estimated allocations remain consi stent with these presentations. Until enacted into federal I aw we will use the known di stribution at this time.

At this time if you should have any questions we would be happy to address those questions and if anyone fromthe public is here we would be happy to
answer thei $r$ questions as well. If for any reason we don't have inf ormati on readily available to us it will be provi ded as soon as possi ble. Does anyone have any comments or questions?

MB. DEMERS: Should we wait until the appropriate bl ock grant is addressed?

MS. GOULD: It's open.
MS. DEMERS: To have a comment or is this all at once?

MS. GOULD: All at once, any questions you have.

MS. DEMERS: I just have some recommendations from the Vermont Associ ation of Community Action Partnershi p. These are fromthe executive directors of the TAP Associ ation and they pertain to the LI KEY bl ock grant and specific sections. Section 42 , crisis fuel el igi bility which is the recei pt of crisis fuel assistance and we recommend that househol ds need not be in recei pt of seasonal fuel assistance in order to recei ve crisis fuel assistance.

Under Subsection 3 the maxi mum number of grants, crisis grants per season, we recommend that the maxi mum number of crisis fuel grants be increased to two grants for househol ds that are i ncome el i gi ble for seasonal fuel assi stance and meet all el igi bility requi rements
for crisis fuel assistance, and we recommend that the maxi mum number of crisis fuel grants be increased to three grants for househol ds that are not eligible for seasonal fuel assistance and meet all eligibility requi rements for crisis fuel assistance.

And under Subsection 4, accessi bility resources, accessi ble resources, we recommend that clients need not obtain specific benefit resources in order to recei ve crisis fuel benefits but instead be encouraged and assisted with appl ying for said benefits.

And then under Section 4.10 crisis
requi rements, assistance should be made available weekends and week ni ghts and hol iday eveni ngs to home bound or physically di sabled or by physically di sabled by phone in addition to the stated hours of 8: $30 \mathrm{a} . \mathrm{m}$ to 4: 00 p.m Saturday, Sundays and state hol idays.

Those are my comments and recommendations.
