# **Dental Imaging Prior Authorization Change**

### **Policy Summary:**

The Vermont Medicaid program removed prior authorization requirements for dental imaging services. This change aligns Medicaid prior authorization requirements for imaging services across all service types. Dental imaging is considered a standard of care versus an exceptional procedure, allows for diagnosis and access to treatment on the date of service, and reduces the need for follow-up visits.

A review of data determined that all prior authorization requests for dental imaging services were approved. Prior authorization is not needed as a utilization control for dental imaging.

Information regarding dental prior authorization requirements and dental programmatic resources can be referenced in the <u>Vermont Medicaid Fee Schedule</u> and <u>Vermont Medicaid</u> Dental Supplement.
