 - Cathedral Square has the administrative infrastructure, training, etc. they are ready to scale up SASH For All
 - Outreach teams work to engage with people experiencing literal homelessnesssuccess is defined as getting people sheltered not permanent housing like other programs. Do housing navigation and Community Resource drop-in center.
 - Seeing much higher rates of SUD and MH challenges.
 - Consistent unrestrictive funding for retention services is crucial. Current funding is a patchwork. Recommendation here?
