# **Children's Personal Care - Parents and Family Members**

## **Policy Summary:**

As part of the response to the <u>COVID-19 Public Health Emergency</u>, Vermont Medicaid is taking steps to ensure Vermonters have access to necessary care and that health care professionals can deliver that care in a safe and timely way. To this end, the following flexibilities are temporarily being instituted for the duration of the public health emergency:

Parents and family members will be allowed to provide personal care services to
individuals through the Children's Personal Care Program overseen by the Vermont
Department of Health. This change is a temporary measure to increase access to care
during the COVID-19 public health emergency.

#### **Effective Date:**

Effective March 15, 2020 lasting for the duration of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.
