Global Commitment 1115 Waiver Home- and Community-Based Services Flexibilities

Policy Summary:

As part of the response to the <u>COVID-19 Public Health Emergency</u>, Vermont Medicaid has received approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) for certain additional flexibilities in its Home- and Community- Based Services (HCBS) programs. These flexibilities are beyond those already permitted under the Global Commitment to Health (GC) 1115 waiver. This has been temporarily approved under the GC 1115 waiver as Attachment R. While <u>Attachment R outlines the HCBS flexibilities that are available to the State</u>, implementation may vary by program, and providers and beneficiaries should seek guidance from HCBS programs directly to understand how these flexibilities are or will be implemented, with the understanding that certain flexibilities will adapt over time or be phased out as the crisis evolves.
