Green Mountain Care Financial Eligibility Standards

Policy Summary:

This is notification that the 2021 Protected Income Level (PIL) and Federal Poverty Level (FPL) financial thresholds for eligibility for Green Mountain Care programs have been updated and implemented effective January 1, 2021. These thresholds, effective for January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, are now available online (links below under “Additional Information”).

Green Mountain Care programs include Medicaid for the Aged, Blind, and Disabled (MABD), Working People with Disabilities, Long-Term Care (LTC) Medicaid, Medicare Savings Programs, and VPharm.
