## **Interim Partial Dentures**

### **Policy Summary:**

The Department of Vermont Health Access (DVHA) is adding interim partial dentures as a Medicaid covered service. This change will allow an interim solution to replace a missing tooth or teeth when medically necessary for beneficiaries under the age of 21. This change includes coverage for the following codes:

- D5820 - interim partial denture (maxillary), includes any necessary clasps and rests
- D5821- interim partial denture (mandibular), includes any necessary clasps and rests.

Specifications: Reimbursement \$250.00 per tooth; members under the age of 21 only. Not a covered benefit for adults. Coverage is limited to 004 Dentist, S06 General Dentistry and T35 VA Dental Clinics to perform this service. Limit of 1 per tooth per lifetime.
